The dash panel is both appealing and unprecedentedly functional. The instruments, clustered in a single dial in front of the driver, in-

clude speedometer, mileage counter, fuel gauge and warning lights for low oil pressure, battery charge and low fuel level.

The electrical equipment includes provision for radio fitment, reversing light, rear fog-light and interior lighting.



Beneath the dash panel there is a deep full-width and padded oddments shelf in the form of a pouch. The ashtray clips to the tubular edge of the pouch: it is easy to unclip and

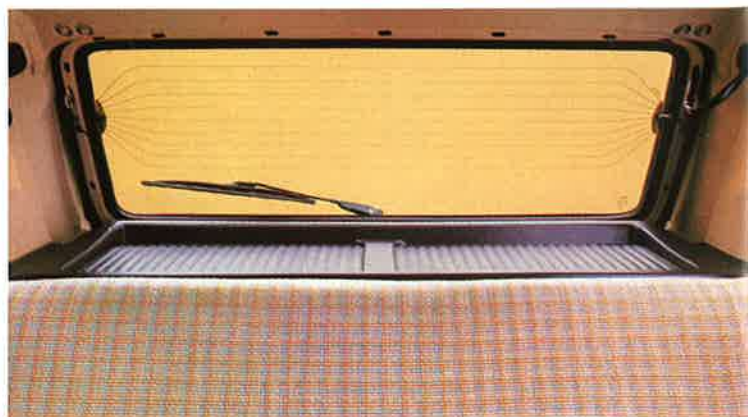
empty and this can be done in seconds: it can also be moved to the left or to the right to wherever it is most convenient.



Additional oddments pockets are fitted into the door panels. Very useful indeed.



Three grab handles for use by the passengers. A reinforced roll-over bar links the two body sides at door pillar level.



On the Panda 45, a parcel shelf is fitted between the base of the rear window and the rear seatback: it conceals the luggage compartment from view and also gives further space for oddments.
