

AnT2nY's 3Dr Fiat Punto Mk2

Remote Central Locking Install

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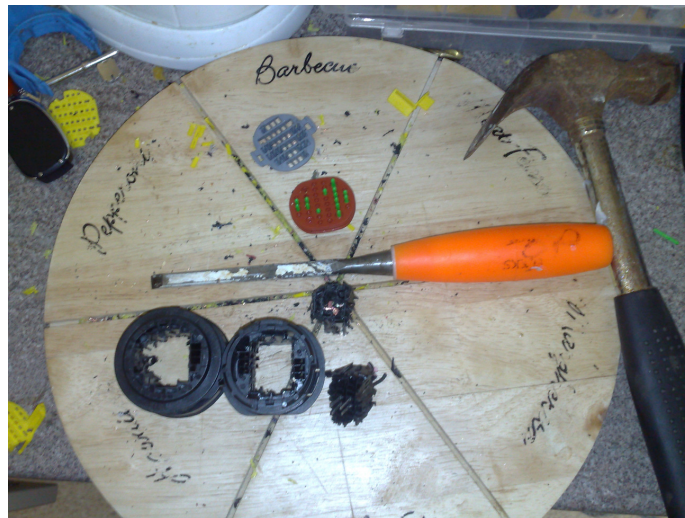
Remove Door cards

Remove door wire channel

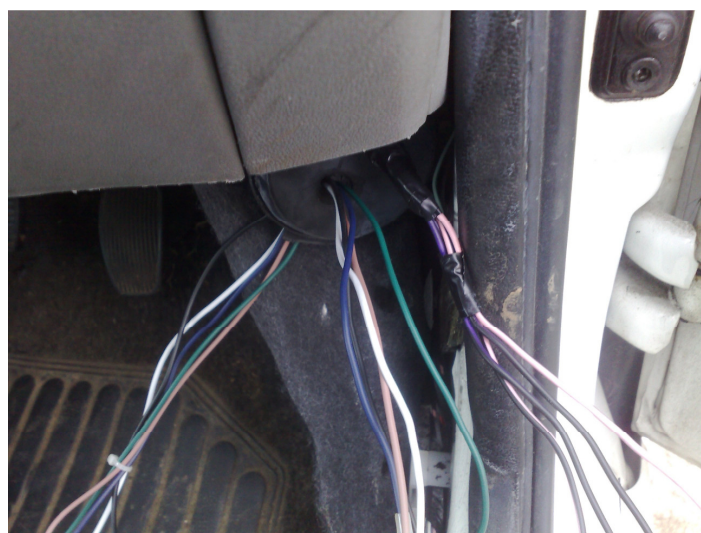


I chisled out the little pins but you could always buy some pins and do it neatly





Cut hole in rubber seal and push the cables through this hole, if you have cut the speaker cables from the connector above i would extend these cabled NOW! As believe me its hard to do it in the little space between the door and the car.





That should be you wires though to the door so now we can install the motors. Remove the bolt circled below, this is the window guide thing, you will want to slide the motor behind this. Also, drill a hole in the door at the angle of the one below, i had to drill 2 holes in both doors because i got it wrong, you can use the metal strip like me or get some washers.



When you are putting the motor in the door, make sure you attach the metal rod to the motor first, as it is impossible to get it in afterwards, I didn't bend mine at this point!

Once hole is drilled, put the motor and the rod in the door but DO NOT screw down! Firstly guide the top of the rod up to the top lock. The below picture is of my finished lock, so do not attach the rod to the lock yet as you need to bend the top once it is in position.



Now you can screw the motor into position as you can see it is behind the window guide, this is why we needed to remove that bolt.



Once it is in position, pull the rod right up so the motor is stretched out and bend the top so it looks like the existing bend on the door lock, this is where you will screw the clamp onto the lock (see 2 pictures up). When you screw on the clamp ensure the screws are facing up, you will need to wind down the window to get the screwdriver there.

THATS IT, just put the wires through to the passenger door (go into the fuse box, down into the centre console where the foot heater fans are, go under the passenger side carpet and repeat on the passenger side door)
